Remember: Tracks can look different in sand, mud, or snow. Animal scat changes color, texture, and shape depending on what the animal eats. These are just examples of what tracks and scat often looks like.

Domestic (pet) Dog

Tracks: can be tiny or huge depending on breed. Claws visible.

Scat: looks like playdough, no fur or bones




Coyote



Tracks: F & R 2.4 - 3.5 in. long. Claws visible Scat: 0.4 - 1.4 in. diameter, usually with fur or bones, one end pointy.










Tracks: F & R 1.5 - 3 in. long. Claws visible. Lots of space between middle toes and pad.

Scat: 0.3-0.75 in. diameter, usually with fur or

bones, one end pointy.

Domestic Cat (outdoor pets or feral cats)








Tracks: F & R 1 - 1.6 in. long. Claws usually not visible. Scat: 0.4 - 0.9 in. in diameter. Looks like tootsie rolls with a pointy end.

White-tailed Deer







Tracks: F & R 1.25 - 4 in. long. Looks like a heart. Scat: Pellets, often with a dimple at one end and a small point on the other. About 0.5 in. diameter

Gray Squirrel



Tracks: F 1.5 in. long, R 1.25 – 3.25 in. long. Claws visible. Scat: Tiny pellets, tubes (not round balls)


Chipmunk R 880

Tracks: F & R about 0.5 in. long. 5 toes visible on R, usually 4 toes visible on F. Scat: Tiny roundish pellets

Eastern Cottontail

Tracks: F 1 - 2 in. long, R 1.25 - 3.25 in. long. Fur usually visible.


Scat: Small round balls, look like cocoa puffs!



Woodchuck (Groundhog)

Tracks: F 2 – 2.75 in. long, R 1.75 – 3 in. long.

Scat: 1-2 in long



Virginia Opossum

Tracks: F & R 1 – 2.75 in. long.

Both F & R have 5 toes. F

looks more like a raccoon
without so much of a "thumb"

Scat: often not found and doesn't always look the same.









Tracks: F 1.75 – 3 in. long, R 2 – 4 in. long. R foot also has

5 long toes.

Scat: 1 in. diameter, 3.5 - 7 in. long.

Muskrat



Tracks: F 1 – 1.5 in. long, R 1.5 – 2.75 in. long. Stiff fur on feet makes them look slightly webbed.



Scat: narrow tubes about 1 in. long

Striped Skunk







Tracks: F & R 1.5 – 2 in. long. R foot also has 5 long toes. Scat: about 0.51 in. diameter, 2 - 5 in. long.
